

Rattenberg am Inn - Service

The glass town with a unique flair
With just 400 inhabitants Rattenberg is Austria's smallest town. The medieval pedestrian zone is dominated by the unique displays of glass craft in the numerous shops. One of the Tyrol's leading museums is the Augustiner Museum with its valuable exhibits. The annually held plays of the Schlossbergspiele and the authentic Rattenberger Advent justify Rattenberg's privilege as cultural centre of the region.



Getting there:

The fastest way to reach Rattenberg am Inn is via the Inn Valley motorway A12 (toll road). Take the motorway to the exit Kramsach. A toll free alternative if coming from Munich is via the Tergernsee/Achenpasse pass.
